The clothing industry accounts for around 10% of global greenhouse emissions and is the world's second biggest industrial polluter, so swapping is a brilliant way to help cut your footprint.

You can bring and take as much as you like, entry is free but donations to Histon and Impington Sustainability Group will be welcomed. There will be homemade cake, teas etc to enjoy whilst your clothes are being sorted between 11am-11.45am.

The Cambridge Community Wardrobe Swish Kit will be launched at the event, thanks to generous funding from South Cambridge District Council's Community Chest Grant.
